## **ETTER** From the Executive Director

## DEAR FRIENDS,

It has been remarkable that the 2020 and 2021 challenges have pushed us to pivot. The pandemic has no bias; our organization and lives were affected more than we knew, especially our students.

We understood we wanted to keep inspiring our kids and build community, even when we couldn't gather in person. Collectively, we brainstormed and modified our practices; we redesigned our program from in-person training to virtual, and our students engaged.

In 2020, we reflected on our mission and thought about what it means to be Running for a Better Oakland (RBO). We decided to make RBO even more accessible to our students, removing all fees and helping us reaffirm our vision of a bigger community where everyone can enjoy the physical and mental benefits of running.

With our Fall 2021 season, we saw our students eager to get back to their in-person practices, and it showed. Our registration has gone back up to pre-pandemic numbers and we are excited to have 250 registered students. Our core focus remains students from Oakland, however, we see kids coming from other areas: Hayward, San Leandro, Alameda, San Francisco and Berkeley. As we looked inward and thought about how we wanted to connect, empower, and impact our students, three initiatives emerged for our focus in 2022. Our goals are:

- Run two additional events for our entire community to help inspire time outside in the winter and explore iconic places in Oakland, such as The Bay Bridge and the Oakland Redwoods.
- Focus on growing our student population to 280 in a calendar year as we represent a wider community, embrace our diversity, and become more inclusive and invite students of all running abilities, communities, and economic status.
- We are increasing and intensifying our outreach efforts to secure corporate funding and grants to maintain RBO programming at no-cost for our students.

These are elevated goals and we are eager to get started. There is so much potential to touch more students than ever before, inspire and empower them to run greater distances while enjoying spending time outside, connecting communities, and creating enduring friendships. All this while raising a generation of runners. I hope you will join us!


